CORE COURSES

Students will be placed in five (5) core classes based upon recommendations.

- English or Honors English
- Math or Honors Algebra I*
- Science or Honors Science
- SS/AR Hist. or Honors SS/AR Hist.
- CTE & Health/PE

Honors courses are designed to prepare students for the Advanced Placement Program. They move at a faster pace, contain challenging material, and will require additional work, per course, outside the normal class day. If your child did not receive a recommendation for an Honors course, you may opt to sign a parental waiver for Honors placement. However, please be advised that you may need to provide additional educational support for your child since Honors courses are rigorous and grades will be indicative of how well a student performs on advanced coursework. The deadline for waivers to be submitted for consideration of Honors placement is August 1, 2025. After this date, waivers will only be accepted if a student's data supports Honors placement and space is available.
